CONGRESSIONAL ART COMPETITION GUIDELINES:

Art works entered in the contest may be up to 28 inches by 28 inches (*including the frame*) and may be up to 4 inches in depth.

Art works may not exceed a weight of 15 pounds. All entries must be an original in concept, design and execution.

The artwork may be:

PAINTINGS

oil, acrylics, and watercolor

DRAWINGS

colored pencil, pencil, ink, markers, pastels, charcoal (*it's recommended that charcoal and pastel drawings be fixed*)

COLLAGE

must be two dimensional

PRINTS

lithographs, silkscreen, and block prints

MIXED MEDIA

Each spring, a nationwide high school arts competition is sponsored by the Members of the U.S. House of Representatives. The *Artistic Discovery* competition is an opportunity to recognize and encourage the artistic talent in the nation.

The Artistic Discovery competition is open to all high school students in Indiana's First Congressional District. The overall winner of this district's competition will be displayed for one year in the U.S. Capitol. The exhibit in Washington will include artwork from other Congressional districts.
